Costumes, Shoes, and Tights:

- Please make sure you organize all of your costumes, tights, shoes, and accessories (**and write your name on the inside of EVERYTHING**)
- Your costume(s) will be sent home as soon as they arrive at TDC.
- Please check “Costumes” on the DSP Parent Portal for information about tights and shoes for each class. Please be sure to acquire the CORRECT tights and shoes prior to recital.
- If you already have tights (in excellent condition with no runs or tears) or if your dance does not require them, you do not need to purchase any.
- If you do not have the appropriate tights, you may purchase on your own or at the studio. [CLICK HERE TO PREORDER](#)
- *For dancers with quick changes, we recommend wearing a nude leotard underneath your costume for easy changing! We have a limited number for sale at the studio or you can purchase online.
- All dancers should keep costumes organized and hung up in a garment bag for transport to Flagler.

Hair:

- For dancers in: Toddlers, 2 Year Old class, Preschool, Combo, and Pre/Kinder Hip Hop:
 - Hair should be pulled straight back securely into a tight, slick bun on the upper back of the head, unless otherwise instructed by your teacher.
- For dancers in Level 1 (1st grade) and up:
 - Hair should be parted down the middle and pulled securely into a low slick bun.

Makeup:

- With lighting onstage, dancers’ faces can look “washed out” if they do not wear appropriate makeup.
 - All female dancers should wear foundation, blush, eye makeup, and RED lipstick.
