→General Rehearsal and Show Information:

- ***This year's RECITALS will celebrate our 30th SEASON!*** We are so excited to have you as a part of such a fun weekend.
- The last day of regular dance classes at TDC is Friday, May 17th. **All rehearsals/shows after this point are at Lewis Auditorium at Flagler College downtown in costume.**
- **Rehearsals** will be **May 21-24** and will be assigned based on your class(es). **Shows** are **May 25-26**. (Both of these will be sent out soon!)
- Tickets are sold online at showtix4u.com. Pre-purchase tickets will be available to **SPONSORS** beginning Wednesday, March 20th. *Tickets go on sale to the public starting Saturday, April 13th at 9am!*
- **Class and individual photos** will be taken during rehearsals in the lobby of Lewis Auditorium.
- Please make sure your dancers have all their correct **costumes**, tights, shoes, hair supplies, and makeup. (Costumes are being sent home as we receive them.) Please make sure everything is labeled and kept in a garment bag.
- Parents will not be allowed backstage during rehearsals or shows; however, we will have a designated section in the auditorium during rehearsals for one family member to quietly watch practice (you are not required to stay).
- You may send clear liquids with your dancer; however, **NO** food is allowed backstage! You must eat prior/after rehearsal or pack a non-messy snack to be eaten in the lobby or outside. (Dancers with longer periods of rehearsals: please bring dinner to eat in lobby.)
- Please clean up your area backstage so that our privilege of using Flagler College Auditorium is upheld in the future!
- Please be respectful and quiet backstage during rehearsals and performances!
